Dear Parade Entrants:

**Thank you for entering the 2022 TABAWANO TEI-NUUMU (OUR PEOPLE'S DAY) PARADE.
Please read the following information.**

- All entries must be ready to go by 10 AM.
- Parade numbers must be placed on the **RIGHT SIDE** and be visible for judging.
- Judges will begin judging at 8:30am. (Please make sure you are in your designated area no later than 8:15am.)
- Try to maintain about 10-15 feet between your entry and the entry in front of you
- The parade route will conclude at the Barlow Lane Gym
- **ALL ENTRIES MUST TAKE PART IN THE PARADE (ENTRIES WHO DO NOT PARTICIPATE IN THE PARADE WILL FORFEIT THEIR PRIZE)**
- Winners will be posted at the Wanaaha Casino
- You must be 21 years of age to redeem your prize (Minors will need to be accompanied by an adult.)
